The County Employees' Charitable Organization (CECO) has served as the charitable arm of the County of San Diego since 1956, awarding grants to support local non-profit organizations that are serving the diverse needs of the San Diego. Grants are made possible by the generosity of County of San Diego and Superior Court employees and retirees.

CECO received 133 grant applications, totaling \$640,361. The CECO Allocation Committee reviewed all of the applications and is recommended that the organizations listed in the table below receive a CECO grant(s) in 2016. On Tuesday, February 23, 2016, the CECO Board of Directors approved the grant recommendations. Grant recipients will be presented their check at the CECO Awards Breakfast on Tuesday, March 22, 2016, at the County Operations Center – Hearing Room.
