



## 2023 CECO GRANTS | RECOMMENDATIONS

Since 1956, the San Diego County Employees' Charitable Organization (CECO) has served as the charitable arm of the County of San Diego. CECO provides grants to local non-profit organizations, and assistance to eligible County employees and retirees in need. CECO is funded by the generosity of County employees and retirees who *Lend a Hand* via recurring or one-time donations, as well as volunteer with CECO.

For the 2023 Community Grants cycle, CECO received 153 applications totaling to more than \$783,000 in requests. On February 16, 2023, the CECO Board of Directors voted to award a total of \$110,252 to the CECO Employee Crisis Fund and local non-profit organizations listed below.
